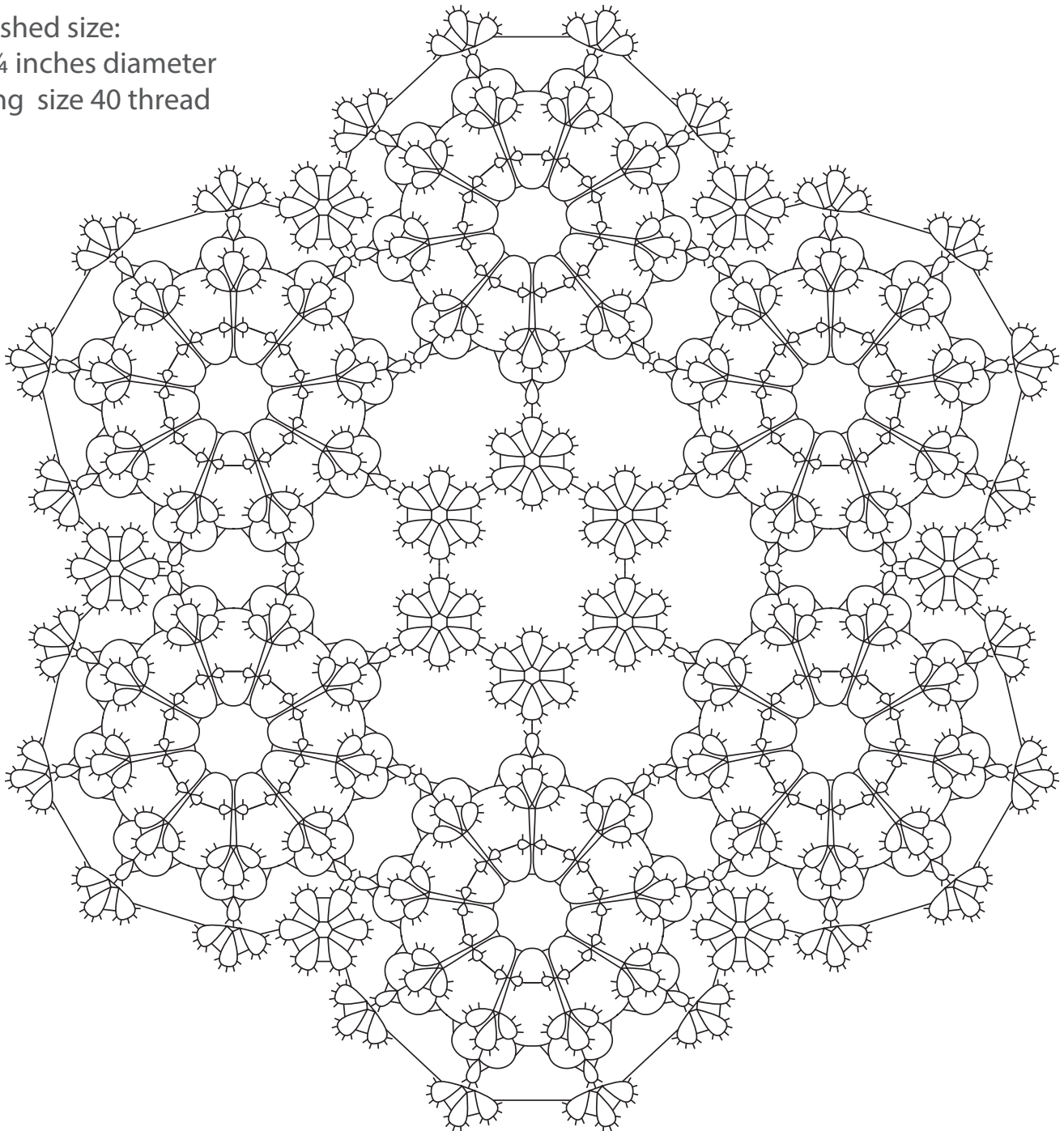

using size 40 thread





UNDERSTANDING THE DIAGRAMS

 indicates the number of shuttles to use or

 indicates to use one shuttle with the ball of thread attached


 start to tat where the arrow points to the diagram and end where it points away

 the rings are depicted as teardrop shapes and chains are arcs. The picots are the small lines on the rings or chains

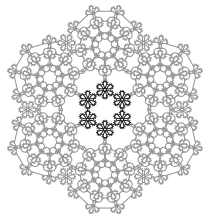
 split rings have a line dividing the ring into sections for the two shuttles (the shaded area indicates sections worked with the second shuttle)

1, 2, 3, ... the number indicates the number of double stitches

A, B, C, ... a letter indicates the order to work the rings and chains (alphabetical order)

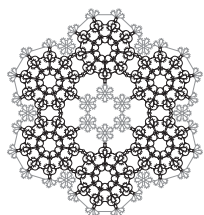
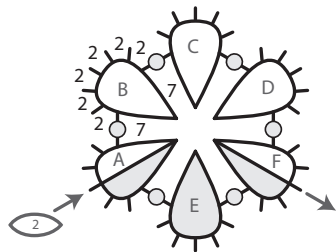
 join at a picot

 join using the shuttle thread



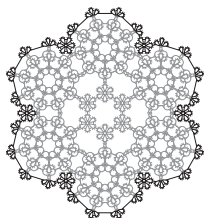
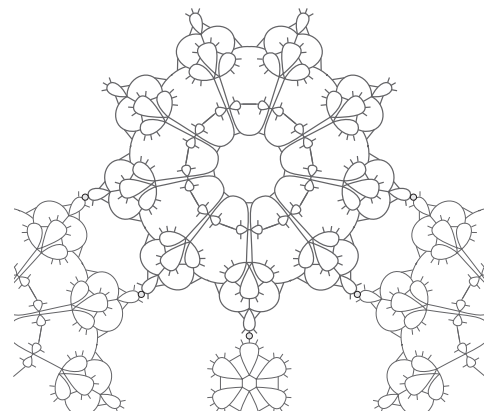
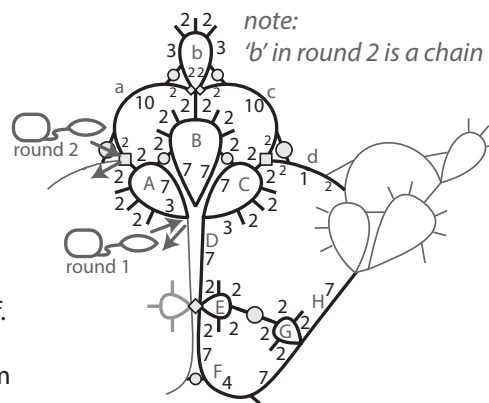
ROUND 1

Repeat pattern 9 times for one motif. Make 6 motifs, joining to each other and round 1 as shown in the diagram to the far right.



ROUND 3

Repeat 6 times joining to round 2 as shown.
