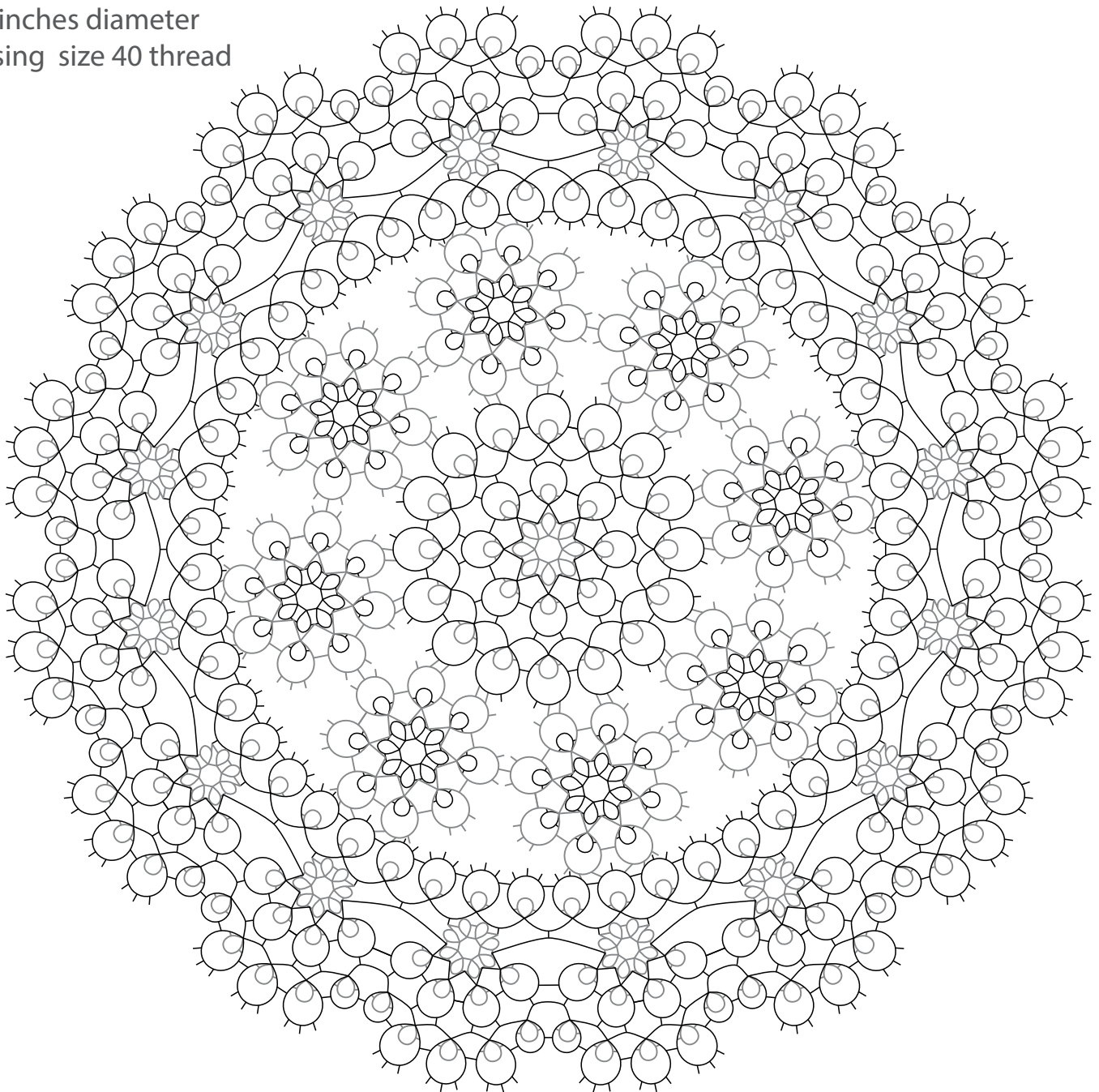







UNDERSTANDING THE DIAGRAMS


-  indicates to use 1 shuttle wound with the first color
-  indicates to use 1 shuttle wound with the second color


 the rings are depicted as teardrop shapes and chains are arcs or straight lines. The picots are the small lines on the rings or chains

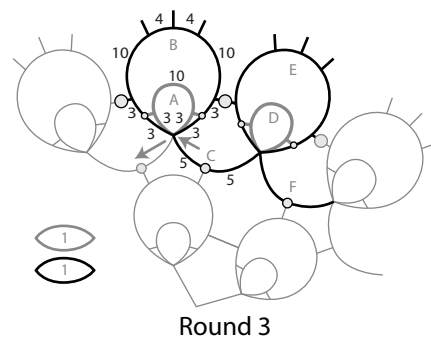
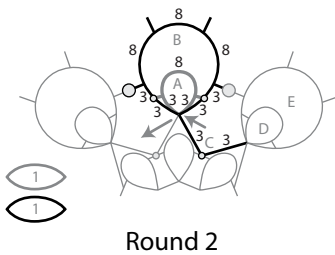
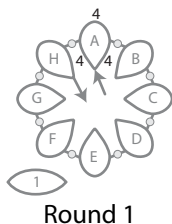
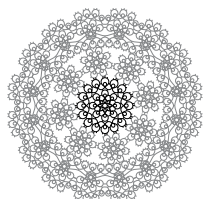
1, 2, 3, ... a number indicates the number of double stitches

A, B, C, ... a letter indicates the order to work the rings and chains (alphabetical order)

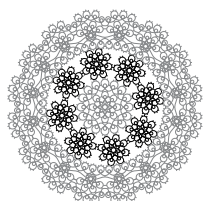
 start to tat where the arrow points to the diagram and end where it points away

 overlapping rings: tat ring A, then tat ring B laying it on top of ring A so that the picot of ring A extends beyond the ring B stitches. Join into the picot

8 x Round 1 and Round 2 with colors switched

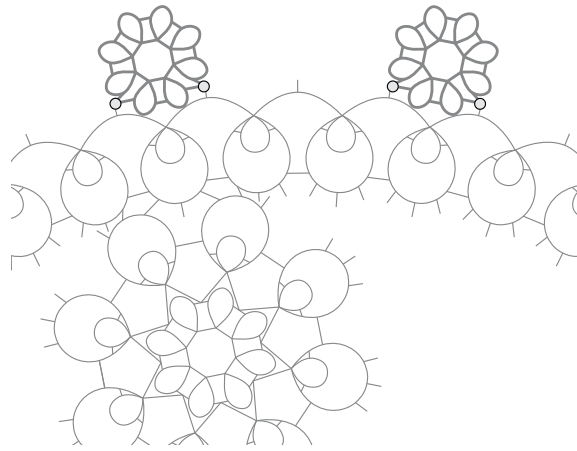

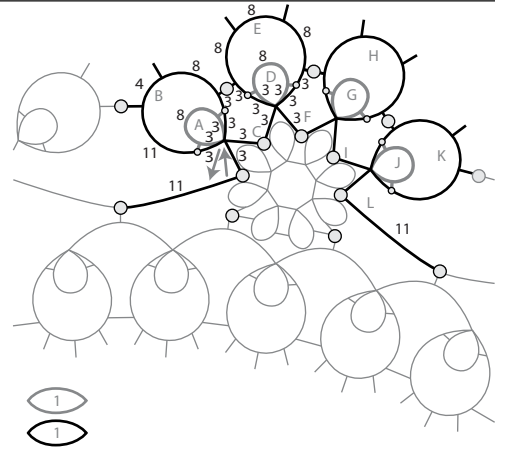




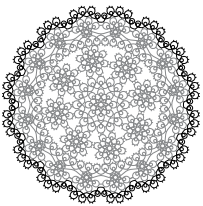
